- Black plimsolls/sandshoes/unbranded plain black comfortable shoe of that style
- For girls only – short white socks. For boys – knee high socks are being provided.
- For girls only – black above the knee shorts to wear under their dresses.

HAIR & MAKE UP (for the Saturday and Sunday show days)

Our Wee Stars will not be wearing stage make up. For hair:

- Boys hair should be off their face, sprayed or gelled, or hair pinned if necessary to keep it away from their face if long.
- Girls hair should be freshly washed and brushed straight, our hair & make up staff will style the girls' hair for consistency.

- Boys hair should be off their face, sprayed or gelled, or hair pinned if necessary to keep it away from their face if long.
- Girls hair should be off the face. If long, please French plait or a high pony plaited. If short, please use hair-colour matching clasps to hold hair off of face. Our make up and hair team will be able to help any children who need their hair plaited – please ensure children come to us with freshly washed and brushed hair and our team can style their hair if needed.
